



NANA JENNY'S KITCHEN

“TISSUE PAPER FLOWERS”

WHAT YOU NEED

- 250g plain sweet biscuits
- tissue paper in a variety of colours
 - scissors
- ribbon, twist tie, pipe cleaner or floral wire.



DIRECTIONS

1. Layer between four and six sheets of tissue paper, you can cut in half and layer again if you like. The larger the sheet of tissue paper, the larger your finished flower will be.
2. Start a fan fold at one end and just fold back and forth.
3. Secure the centre with a piece of ribbon, a twist tie, a pipe cleaner or floral wire.
4. Cut each end of the folded paper so the edges are rounded.
5. Open up the fan on each side.
6. Then pull up each layer of tissue paper towards centre. Be gentle – tissue paper can tear easily!
7. If you wish, you can glue the flower onto a stick for the stem.
